Ohio Health Information Partnership Advisory Board Update

- Adoption Committee Recommendations
 1. Incorporate messaging standards consistent with national development organizations such as HL-7
 2. With respect to EMR/EHR only support vendors with CCHIT or other like certification
 3. Adopt the recommendations of the HISPC with respect to security and privacy of patient data
 4. Develop an assessment tool to assist in the implementation of EHR
 5. Serve as a grant clearinghouse for training and education

Ohio Health Information Partnership Advisory Board Update

- Exchange Committee Recommendations
- 1. Develop a web portal that summarizes data at both the professional level and patient level
- 2. Financial recommendations to be delegated to the OHIP Finance Committee
- 3. The state of Ohio should provide incentives to move institutions into the direction of electronic exchange
- 4. Embrace standards of the Office of the National Coordinator

Ohio Health Information Partnership Advisory Board Update

- Governance Committee Recommendations
- 1. Draft Mission and Purposes for an Ohio Health Information Partnership
- 2. Recommends that a governing body be established no larger than twenty to twenty-five individuals representing a wide spectrum of stakeholders
- 3. Recommends that the current OHIPAB structure is a good model for the OHIP organization to follow, including the current finance, exchange and
- 4. adoption committees. The subcommittee further suggests adding a nomination committee and a technology committee
- 5. Recommends the formation of a nonprofit Ohio corporation as the legal entity structure for the Ohio Health

Ohio Health Information Partnership Advisory Board Update

- Finance Committee Recommendations
- 1. Determine most appropriate tax exempt status for Ohio's statewide entity
- 2. Define Infrastructure needs by its 3 components and capture high-level cost estimates for each component
- 3. The Finance Committee will identify existing and potential sources of funding to support the 3 components of HIT/HIE infrastructure.
- 4. Business case models will be developed for all 3 components utilizing the recommended format in order to develop cost benefit analysis and return on investment
- 5. Develop strategies for Stakeholder Financing
- 6. Demonstrate the value and business case for investment in health information exchange by sharing best practices
- 7. Research and develop proposal for state-funded loan program for EHR users
- 8. Develop Business case models that are consistent with federal initiatives and regulations

Ohio Health Information Partnership Advisory Board Update

- What's next?
 - Consolidate 21 recommendations to reflect policy direction
 - Continue to foster dialogue with other initiatives such as HIPSC or Department of Insurance Real-time Claims Adjudication project (HB 125)
 - Develop final report detailing policy recommendations for Office of the Governor and State Legislators
